


St Andrew's Church Parish of Killyman Magazine August/September 2022

Members attended the Diocesan Festival in St Patrick's Cathedral in Armagh on 1st June .







learnt that they need Jesus with them every day of their lives. Thank you to all the Parishioners who contributed with donations of food and drinks for the snacks each evening.






